Good signs of success for right human relations!

“One person in five is estimated to participate in some form of civil society organisation.” (quoted from the Human Development Report 2000, page 5) More than one billion people have re-oriented their thinking and their lives towards the common good. Is this not a good sign?

Philosophers and educators, economists and business people, all start speaking about putting people first, about the priority of the human being over profits, about the need for a culture of peace instead of violence and exploitation. Global campaigns for disarmament, protection of the environment, social and economic justice gather increasingly more supporters. An example is the Global Campaign for Peace Education launched by the Hague Appeal for Peace (<http://www.ibp.org>). The healing powers of the human being are increasingly recognised.

No wonder that so many conflicts and wars are being financed all over the world. The only hope of those who seek to remain in power at all costs is to divide. Their instruments are all those who let themselves be misguided by hate and prejudice. These people are encouraged and brought to positions of power in which they can do the most harm. However, even the suffering they inflict on their fellow beings helps their victims awaken to spiritual values. The philosopher Laurency says in his book, “The Knowledge of Reality” (pages 46 and 49): “Life is joy, happiness and bliss in the mental and all higher worlds. Suffering is found only in the three lower regions of the physical and emotional worlds, and then only as bad reaping after bad sowing.”

In the same way as many totalitarian systems have collapsed in the past decades, totalitarian systems based on the capitalist model will also break down.

The people of Earth become increasingly aware of the manipulations used to control them, as demonstrated by the growing strength of organisations such as ATTAC (Association pour une Taxation des Transactions financières pour l'Aide aux Citoyens, Association for Taxation of Financial Transactions for the People's benefit, <http://www.attac.org>), which denounce the speculative policies of today's political and economic systems.

More and more earth citizens understand that unity in diversity and right human relations represent the only real future for humanity and hope for collective happiness. Thousands of books and articles are published by numerous groups and organisations in all possible languages, in all countries. We are glad to add our contribution to this flow of positive and constructive information. As our friends in the Ukraine declared in their appeal during their conference last June: Let us all cooperate to create an environment of pure information on our planet! We extend this invitation to all our readers, in order to strengthen the wave of active goodwill on our planet and to help spread the light of our global human family in order to dominate darkness and fear, hate and ignorance.

GROUP MEETINGS AND ACTIVITIES

4-9 May 2001 – Gathering of World Service Intergroup, Darjeeling, India

The purpose of the WSI is to generate a focused, conscious and deliberate intergroup effort to specifically assist the externalisation of the Hierarchy and the reappearance of the Christ, the World Teacher. Its members are education and meditation groups (including the IPS) located around the world, who study and honour all of the great spiritual teachings of the ages, especially the more modern presentations by H.P. Blavatsky, Alice Bailey, Helena Roerich and other teachers of the Ageless Wisdom.

One of the ongoing projects of the WSI is to hold a meeting and meditation retreat every year in one of the 5 planetary centres (Geneva, London, New York, Tokyo and Darjeeling). This year the meeting was held in Darjeeling and gathered about 40 representatives of groups from several countries. The main ideas exchanged during the meeting were summarised in the "Darjeeling Declaration", which can be read at the WSI website (<http://www.synthesis.tc>). Spanish) from the IPS Geneva or any of the other participating groups. It is mainly intended for people with an esoteric background.

6 May 2001- Alcor Institute Launching Day

Alcor Institute is a non-profit-making association which aims to develop a certain number of activities, including seminars, conferences and publications, to set up research groups and organise a training course based on the Ageless Wisdom and the discoveries of modern science. Two of the members of the IPS Executive Committee, Rudolf Schneider and Alice Boainain-Schneider, have participated in its foundation, but the IPS is not involved in the activities of the Alcor Institute.

During the launching day, the planned activities of the Institute were outlined. During the second preparatory committee meeting for the World Conference against Racism (WCAR), a group of NGOs established a network on education and set up an Education Caucus. During the third preparatory committee in Geneva, this group held daily meetings and formed working groups to work on inputs for the Declaration and Plan of Action of the NGO Forum which will take place in Durban, in parallel to the WCAR, and to work out an oral statement in the name of the Education Caucus for the government conference. Education is the key to the promotion of respect for harmony in diversity of societies.
